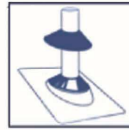
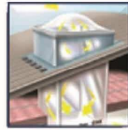


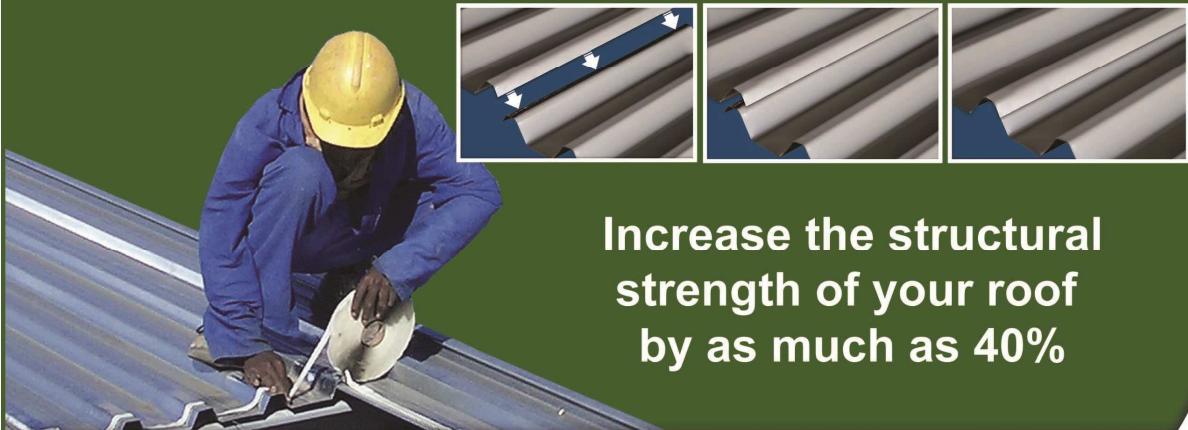

- Butyl tape seals against moisture and rust. (Non-porous).
- Has an effective life of over 20 years.
- Oxidation, Chemical and age resistant
- Will not degrade under UV.
- Will not crack or lose adhesion under expansion and contraction.
- Heat resistant up to 120 deg C.
- Non Toxic and non Hazardous.
- Butyl Tape adheres to galvanised iron, polycarbonate, PVC and fibre glass.
